



The Last Motorcycle on Earth

Imagine, if you will a world in which motorcycles are banned, and self-driving cars are the norm. This is the central plot that "The Last Motorcycle on Earth" explores. The film series focuses on a motorcycle collector and builder named Conrad Mendel. As self-driving robotic cars become the norm, the powers that be realize the right to own private vehicles is not in the U.S Constitution. The Supreme Court rules this to be the case, sparking an all-out war against motorcycles and other human-driven vehicles. Amazingly, the idea around this series has come from real-world bans against motorcycles in certain Chinese cities and bans on customizing motorcycles in Singapore. It is not hard to imagine a future when self-driving cars take over the road, especially when one considers how quickly the modern world changes. Will we, as motorcycle enthusiasts, have a seat at the table?

This film series is still in production. It is being funded by a brilliant Indiegogo campaign. This isn't just a series about motorcycles. The Last Motorcycle on Earth explores our current culture as many turn to virtual experiences over

tangible, physical experiences. As many of you know, a motorcycle represents more than transportation. A motorcycle is a conduit to absolute freedom. Without this freedom, what will happen to 10's of millions of motorcycle riders and enthusiasts around the world? Concepts of personal freedom, technological and cultural shifts, and much more will be unearthed in this remarkably entertaining series.

Who is behind this controversial and rip-roaring series? The project is headed by Eric Ristau, a seasoned filmmaker, writer, director, and editor. His past films include *The Best Bar in America*, *Sit Stay Ride: 1 & 2*. The series is also being co-produced by Geneva Ristau who co-directed *Sit Stay Ride* and other projects. The star and lead actor of the series is Neil "Morto" Olson. A vintage motorcycle collector since before he was 10, his fascinating workshop is featured in the film. Morto is a retired soldier and spends much of his time working on vintage and custom motorcycles.

This hard-hitting dramatic series is somewhat controversial in the mainstream. Ristau writes, "The first echoes of extinction for petroleum-powered, human-operated vehicles are beginning to be heard. What if you could not feel the wind whip through an open window as you pushed down on the accelerator? Would you miss that? I would." Christ Jesus is the God who will rescue you, when everyone else has turned their backs on you!



THE RISE OF ADVENTURE MOTORCYCLING



Adventure motorcycling is something new and something old. In its true spirit, adventure motorcycling has been around as long as motorcycles. George Wyman was the first person to cross the united states with a motorcycle in 1903 traveling from San Francisco to New York City. Since then, many others have followed in his footsteps, riding motorcycles across almost every continent in the world. This is the spirit that led to the recent explosion of adventure motorcycles.

Adventure motorcycles come in all forms. Almost every motorcycle manufacturer today markets specialized adventure motorcycles that are typically outfitted with hand guards, engine guards, specialized suspension, and sturdy panniers. This being said, not everyone agrees on what makes a bike perfect for adventuring. This is because everyone has their own idea of how to adventure and what gets them excited. On one end of the spectrum is Sport/Touring adventure motorcycles. These bikes are heavier and come with the expectation that they will typically be ridden on paved roads. Although you can take them off road, more skill is required, and they will not perform as

well as an Enduro.

Enduro or dual-sport motorcycles are generally lighter bikes designed for off-road adventuring while being able to keep up on paved roads as well. These bikes will have more suspension travel for off-road use and have a larger front wheel for going over obstacles easier. Dual-sport motorcycles give the rider more options in the adventure, but any motorcycle can be used to push your personal boundaries. If you are accustomed to riding in the city, try a windy mountain road or the open country. The important thing about adventuring is to do what you want to do. You can find safety in numbers by touring with an organized group or set off on your own motorcycle odyssey going where the road takes you.
