

OKLAHOMA BIKER - THE RIPERS MAGAZINE







John William Brooks III, of Sapulpa, passed from this life on January 28th, at his home.

John was born November 7th, 1972, to Kathy Capella and John William Brooks, Jr. He graduated from Broken Arrow High School. He was employed by John Christner Trucking.

He was involved in Masonic Lodge and a life member of the OK Riders MC.

John enjoyed in his spare time, shooting his guns, going to concerts and spending time with his family and friends.

He had a caring and compassionate heart and was always willing to give a helping hand. He was loved and will be greatly missed by all his family and friends.

He is preceded in death by his mother, Kathleen Capella.

He is survived by his father, Bill Brooks; sons Blake Brooks and Dallas Campbell; Brother Blake Brooks; sisters Kristy Day, Amy Wiley and Brittany Brooks and a host of other relatives and friends.





Born in 1970 with the advent of the new AMA Racing equivalency formula, the XR750 was created by Harley-Davidson's Race Team Manager Dick O'Brian and team to replace the highly successful outgoing KR750.

Using a Sportster-based engine, the XR750 utilized modified cast-iron heads and cylinders, a magneto instead of

generator, and improved oiling. In 1972, a new, more powerful all-aluminum alloy XR750 engine was introduced.

The perfected machine dominated flat track racing for decades to come. Between 1972 and 2008, the XR750 would go on to win 28 of 37 AMA Grand National Championships. The XR750 racked up more wins than





any other motorcycle in AMA racing history and earned the description of being the "most successful race bike of all time."

In addition, the XR750 became a cultural icon with legendary stuntman Evel Knievel at the handlebars. Evel Knievel began jumping an XR750 at the height of his career from 1970 to 1976, and alongside the exploits of the racing versions of the XR750 inspired a generation to ride.

The road racing version of the XR-750 used an aluminum oil tank, had a 6 US gal (23 I; 5 imp gal) fiberglass fuel tank, and a fiberglass fairing which included extra heat shielding to protect the rider's left leg when riding in a tuck position. On the top center of the fuel tank was a leather pad with a round cutout for the left-side fuel filler cap. Like the dirt





tracker, it used a Ceriani fork and Girling shocks, two 36 mm Mikuni carburetors and tuned dual reverse cone exhaust. Instrumentation consisted of a Smiths tachometer.

Unlike the dirt tracker, it came with brakes: a rear disc brake. and in front, a Fontana four leading shoe drum brake, which is two twin leading drum brakes paired side by side in two drums. The XRTT is the final example of a competition motorcycle with drum brakes, superseded by disc brakes on all other racing bikes due to the excessive unsprung weight added by the very large drum brake assembly. The official horsepower was never published, but estimates for the early 1972 engines were in the high 70–79 hp (52–59) kW) range, increasing to an estimated 100 hp (75 kW) or more by 2008.

As with the KR, customers began asking for a street-legal XR from its debut. Harley-Davidson was slow

to capitalize on this demand, finally introducing the Sportster XR-1000 street bike for the 1983 model year, 13 years after the XR-750 racer. The XR-1000 used XR-750 heads. but kept the Sportster engine, frame and other equipment. Costing nearly twice the price of a base model Sportster XL, the XR-1000 sold poorly and many performance enthusiasts simply bought an XL and upgraded the heads, carburetors and exhaust themselves at significantly less total cost. The XR-1000 was discontinued after only two years, and after another 24 years the Harley-Davidson XR1200 was introduced in 2008 in Europe and 2009 in the US. The XR1200 has less in common with the XR-750 than the XR-1000 did, but found a warmer reception.

In 2020, the Harley-Davidson Factory Flat Track team returned to field Harley-Davidson's production-based tradition for factory flat track campaigns. The updated XG750R flat tracker, powered by the liquid-cooled, fuelinjected and race-tuned 750cc Harley-Davidson® Revolution X™ V-Twin is based on the production engine originally designed for the Harley-Davidson Street 750 motorcycle.







"Well I can think of one thing," the man offered.




