PTSD

the Silent Killer

The VA has not had the most illustrious history diagnosing and treating PTSD. In the distant past, the VA's main answer to PTSD was pills, pills and more pills. Like many aspects of the VA, their medical practices have moved more to the forefront. PTSD can ruin lives and may play a part in triggering suicides in men and women. VA providers are working hard to identify and treat PTSD.

How Common Is PTSD Among Veterans? – PTSD is more common among veterans than it is in the general population, and even greater among service members who experience combat. According to the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, 15% of Vietnam veterans are struggling with PTSD, and around 30% experienced PTSD at some point in their lifetimes. In a given year, around 12% of Gulf War veterans and between 11% and 20% of Operations Iraqi Freedom and Enduring

Freedom veterans experience PTSD.

Identifying if you may have PTSD – Sometimes things happen to people that are unusually or especially frightening, horrible, or traumatic. For example, a serious accident or fire, a physical or sexual assault or abuse, an earthquake or flood, a war, seeing someone be killed or seriously injured, or having a loved one die through homicide or suicide. If you ever experienced this kind of event, take this PTSD screening test. In the past month, have you:

Had nightmares or thought about the event(s), when you didn't want to?

Tried hard not to think about the event(s) or went out of your way to avoid situations that reminded you of the event(s)?

Been constantly on guard, watchful, or easily startled?

[] Felt numb or detached from people, activities, or your surroundings?

[] Felt guilty or unable to stop blaming yourself or others for the event(s) or problems

If you answered “yes” to 3 or more of these questions, talk to a mental health care provider to learn more about PTSD and PTSD treatment. This does not mean you have PTSD. Only a mental health care provider can tell you for sure.

Trauma-focused Treatments

– Trauma-focused treatment psychotherapies are the most highly recommended treatments for PTSD. “Trauma-focused” means that the treatment focuses on the memory of the traumatic event or its meaning. The following are three of the most effective trauma focused psychotherapies for PTSD. In each of these psychotherapies, you’ll meet with a therapist once or twice a week, for 50 to 90 minutes. You and your therapist will have specific goals and topics to cover during each session. Treatment usually lasts for 3 to 4 months. Then, if you still have symptoms, you and your therapist can talk about other ways to manage them. PTSD therapy helps change your relationship with the trauma,

not erase your memories.

Prolonged Exposure

Therapy (PE) – People with PTSD often try to avoid things that remind them of the trauma. While this may help you feel better in the moment, in the long term it can keep you from recovering from PTSD. In PE, you expose yourself to the thoughts, feelings, and situations that you’ve been avoiding. It sounds scary, but facing things you’re afraid of in a safe way can help you learn that you don’t need to avoid reminders of the trauma.

Cognitive Processing

Therapy (CPT) – After a trauma, it’s common to have negative thoughts — like thinking what happened is your fault or that the world is very dangerous. CPT helps you learn to identify and change these thoughts.

Eye Movement

Desensitization and

Reprocessing (EMDR) –

People with PTSD react negatively to the memory of their traumas. EMDR can help you process these upsetting memories, thoughts, and feelings. You’ll focus on specific sounds or movements while you talk about the trauma. This helps your brain work through the traumatic memories. Over time, you


can change how you react to memories of your trauma. During EMDR, your therapist will ask you to choose a memory from the trauma and identify the negative thoughts, emotions, and feelings in your body that go with it.

Support Groups – In a support group, you talk about your day-to-day problems with other people who have had similar experiences.

Support groups can be a good addition to PTSD treatment, or something you can do after you've gotten treatment — but they won't treat your PTSD.

Alternative Treatments

– According to John Hopkins School of Medicine Researchers, the psychoactive drug MDMA (ecstasy) has been designated by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration as a “breakthrough therapy” for PTSD, meaning that the agency will fast-track the development and review of clinical trials to test it. However,



the researchers caution that MDMA may not work for every psychiatric condition linked to social behaviors.

While limited studies suggests a potential decrease in PTSD symptoms with the use of medicinal marijuana, there is a notable lack of large-scale trials, making any final conclusions difficult to confirm at this time.

The Forgotten Spring Tuneup

Spring is fast approaching. Time to dust off your ride, check off your tuneup and safety list in preparation for a long, adventurous riding season. There is one important step that many bikers forget to check – insurance. Let's review some important aspects of insurance and your motorcycle.

Insurance Card – Everyone knows that you are required to have at least compulsory insurance before you can drive your motorcycle on the road. The state maintains a database of active motor vehicle insurance policies verses vehicle registrations. Unfortunately this database is not always as current as it should be. When a police officer runs your tag number, the dispatcher checks it against the insurance and the National Crime Information Computer (NCIC) "wanted and warrants" databases. There are times when this check may show that your vehicle is uninsured, even though you actually have insurance in effect. When you switch insurance companies your old company sends an update to the state insurance database showing that you no longer have insurance with them. The database may not have been

updated showing your new insurance information. That is why it is important to carry a current insurance card on your motorcycle. When you change insurance companies or renew your premium, be sure to get an updated insurance card.

Uninsured Coverage – Oklahoma ranks among one of the highest states in the nation with uninsured motorists. An article in the Journal Record estimates that as many as 60,000 (4.3%) of Oklahoma motorists drive without the required auto insurance. If you are in a crash with one of these drivers, you will have to foot the entire bill to repair your motorcycle, and the medical bills to repair your body. Even if the vehicle in the collision does have insurance, if you have medical expenses, your medical costs will probably far exceed the amount of the other driver's insurance. It is not uncommon for the medical costs of a motorcyclist to exceed \$100,000. Oklahoma requires motorists to carry coverage of \$25,000 in bodily injury or death, \$50,000 in total bodily injury or death, and \$25,000 in property damage. If the driver of the other vehicle is unlicensed, the vehicle insurance might

not provide any coverage. AAA estimates that 20% of the drivers in Oklahoma do not have a valid driver's license. Talk to your insurance agent to see about adding uninsured motorists (UM) coverage. Usually, if you have UM on one vehicle, you are covered for all your vehicles insured by that company.





He said to the class, "Everyone who thinks you are dumb, please stand up."


He didn't think anybody would stand, & was gonna make a point how nobody really is dumb, but about that same time one little kid stood up.


