

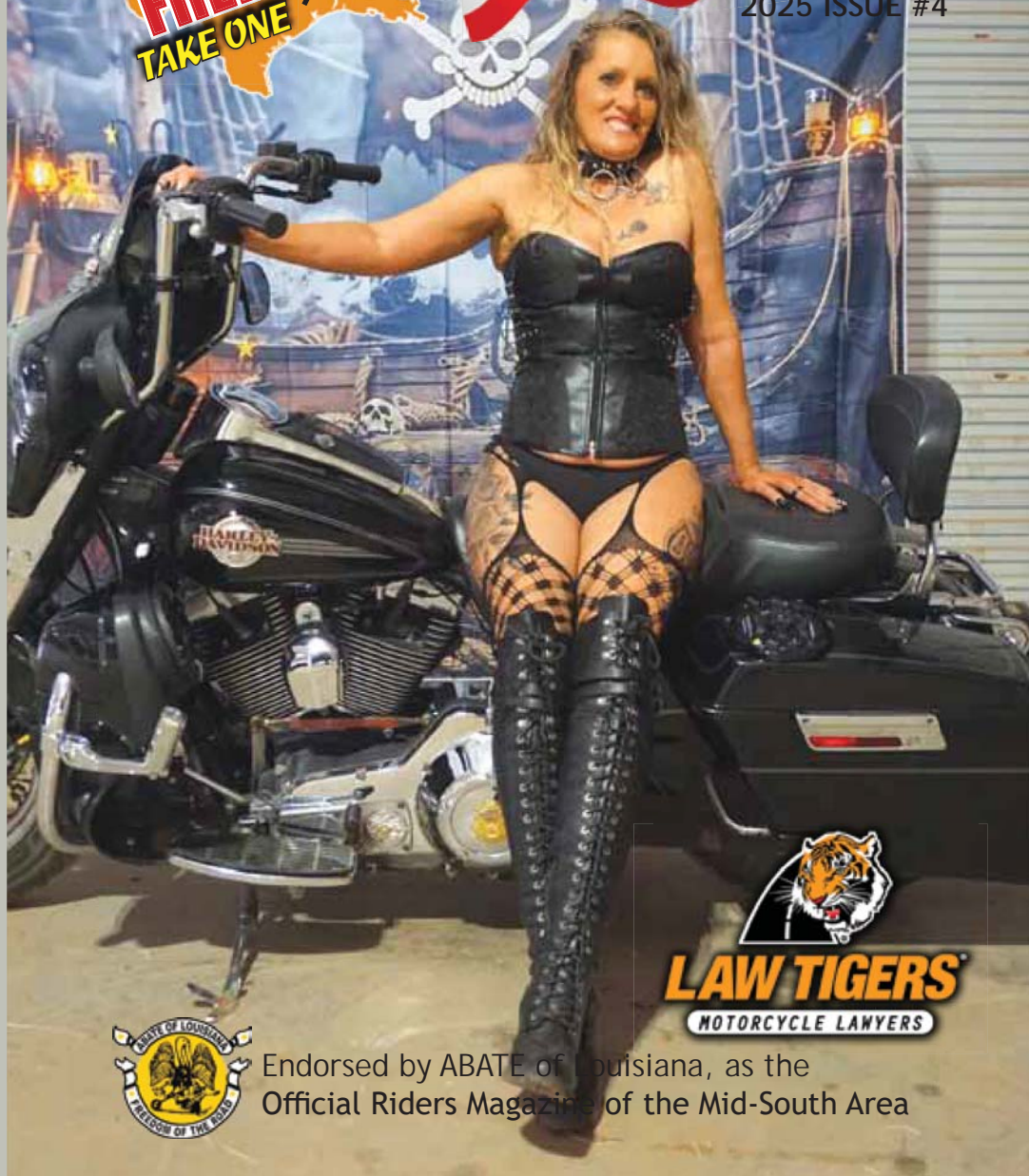

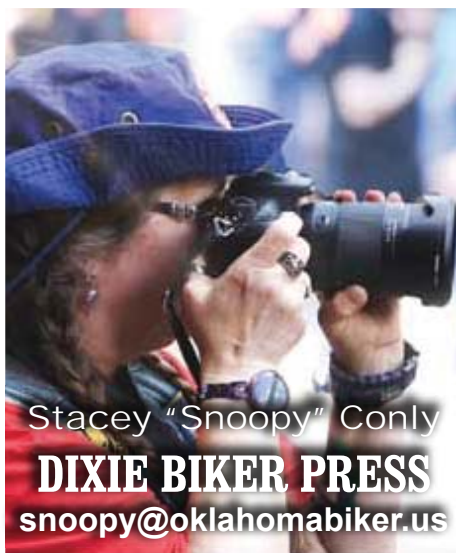

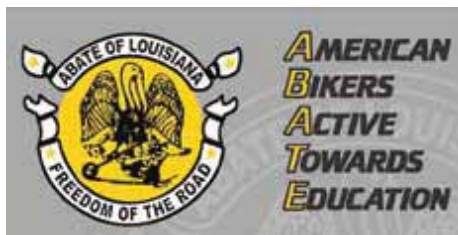

FLAGS OVER THE DAM

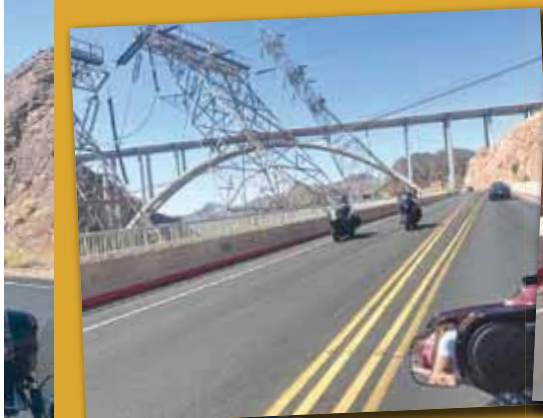
